SCHOOL PHOTOS

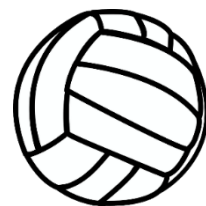
Single/Family school photos will be taken on **WEDNESDAY 9TH OCTOBER** at 9:00am. If you would like a family photo, please notify the school office.
