

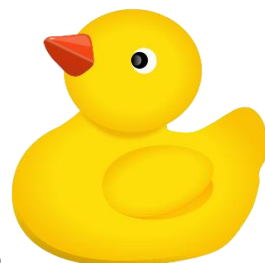


### **HEAD OF SCHOOL**

### PARENTS EVENING

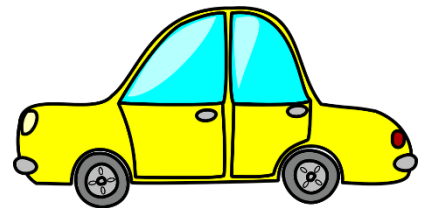
An informal parents evening will take place on **MONDAY 15<sup>TH</sup> JULY** from 3:20pm to 4:30pm.
