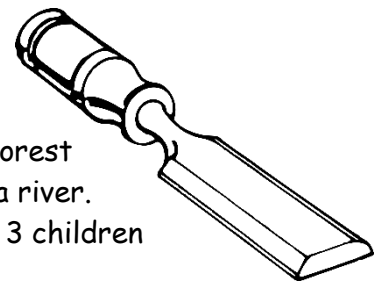


CAKE AND BOOK SALE

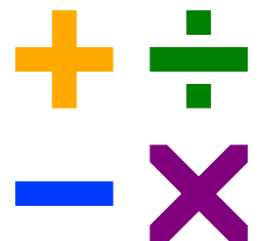
SCIENCE WEEK
