GREY/ BLACK	Trousers or shorts
GREY / BLACK	Skirts
GREEN	School Sweatshirt or Sweatcardi
YELLOW	School Polo Shirt
GREEN & WHITE	Gingham Summer Dress
BLACK FOOTWEAR	Black shoes (fashion shoes, shoes with high heels or open toe are NOT suitable for school)
SOCKS	Black, grey, white
ESSENTIAL PE KIT:	PE bag, Trainers (not plimsolls), Fitted black PE shorts or/Black shadow stripe PE shorts, T-shirt (Bottle Green with school logo), Spare sport socks. Children taking part in football will need football boots and shin pads.

PLEASE HELP US TO HELP YOUR CHILDREN TO CARE FOR THEIR CLOTHES BY LABELLING EACH ITEM.

There is also a second-hand school uniform box in the school office.

No jewellery (earring-small studs or sleepers) or nail varnish to be worn. Long hair to be tied back.
