## MORNING AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

**Breakfast Club** continues to run from **8:00am - 8:40am**. The price is **£3.00 per child per session, including breakfast** - toast, cereal, muffins, crumpets and orange juice, milk or water. Children have access to a range of equipment and games and if weather permits, we will often get out for a breath of fresh air! Children also have the opportunity to complete reading or homework with a member of staff if required.



**After School Club** continues to run from 3:10pm - 5:00pm Monday – Friday. **The price is £4.00 per child per session.** There will be two sessions that run from **3:10pm – 4:00pm and 4:00pm – 5:00pm**. This club includes a healthy snack, drinks and access to indoor and outdoor play as well as the opportunity to complete reading or homework with a member of staff if required.

Please note: if your child attends a session for 10 minutes or 1 hour you will still be charged the £4.00.

**All sessions are to be booked and paid for on ParentPay by the previous Friday – the initial glitch this week should be resolved by the weekend.**
