CONTACT TRACING OVER THE HALF-TERM

Schools continue to play an important role in contact tracing for the pupils and staff who are attending schools at the moment, and we will continue the process of tracing over the half term break.

If pupils or staff still attending school in person test positive for COVID-19 during the holiday, having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, schools are not required to take any action. Staff, parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

If pupils or staff still attending school test positive, having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, please contact us and we will identify close contacts and advise self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school.



The Spring Bank Holiday in 2022 will be moved to Thursday 2nd June and an additional Bank Holiday on Friday 3rd June will see a four-day weekend to celebrate Her Majesty the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. As we will already be on our half term break in the week commencing 31st May, the number of days pupils need to be in school has been reduced nationally from 195 days to 194 in total for 2021-22. 
