



HEAD OF SCHOOL NOTE

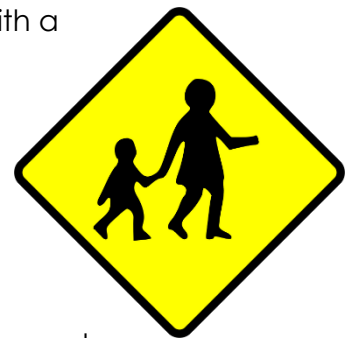
We continue to be incredibly proud of how well our pupils have settled back into the routine of school life. Thank you for maintaining social distancing on site and waiting patiently to enter the school site.
